

HUME AND HOVELL TRACK CLOSURES

BUSHFIRES BURNT THROUGH APPROXIMATELY 120KM OF THE HUME AND HOVELL TRACK DURING JANUARY 2020. SUBSEQUENT HEAVY RAINS CAUSED ADDITIONAL DAMAGE TO THE TRACK SURFACE AND SOME INFRASTRUCTURE.

WHILE SOME SECTIONS OF THE TRACK HAVE REOPENED, APPROXIMATELY 32KM OF THE HUME AND HOVELL TRACK IS CLOSED BETWEEN BLOWERING CAMPSITE (SOUTH OF TUMUT) AND BUDDONG FALLS PICNIC AREA (SOUTH OF TALBINGO).

THE COL DANIEL BRIDGE, WHICH IS LOCATED ON TUMBARUMBA CREEK, WAS DESTROYED BY FLOODS IN NOVEMBER 2021. THE BRIDGE HAS NOW BEEN REBUILT AND IS OPEN TO TRACK USERS.

TIN MINES ROAD BETWEEN TIN MINES CAMPSITE AND JINGELIC ROAD WAS AFFECTED BY BUSHFIRE AND IS UNDER THE CONTROL OF NPWS. THIS SECTION OF TRACK IS NOW OPEN. CHECK WITH NPWS FOR FURTHER INFORMATION AND THE LATEST STATUS.

SIGNAGE HAS BEEN INSTALLED AT THE ENTRY AND EXIT POINTS OF THE CLOSED SECTIONS OF TRACK. TRACK USERS SHOULD NOT ENTER THESE ZONES DUE TO THE RISK OF TREE-FALL AND LANDSLIDES.
